## 「Cedar Pollen」

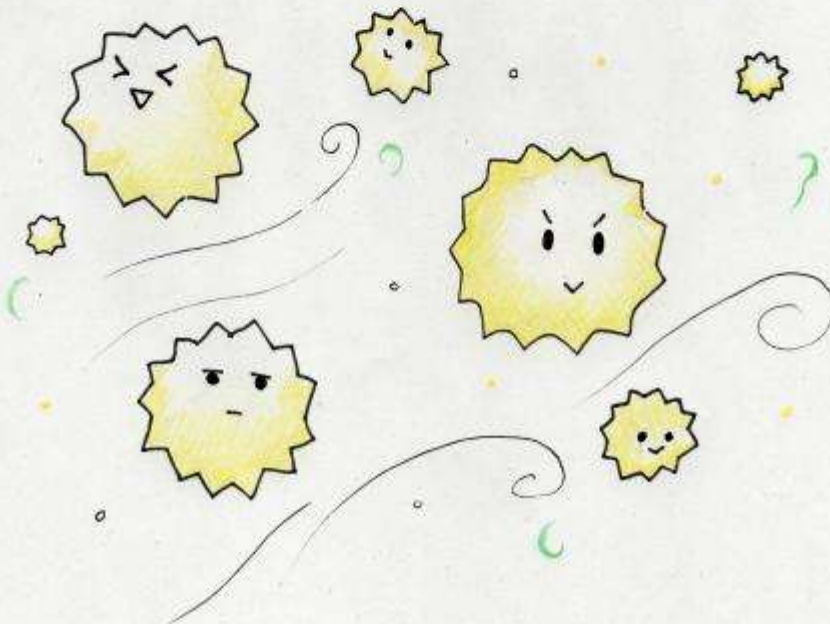

# 「Fossil Collecting」

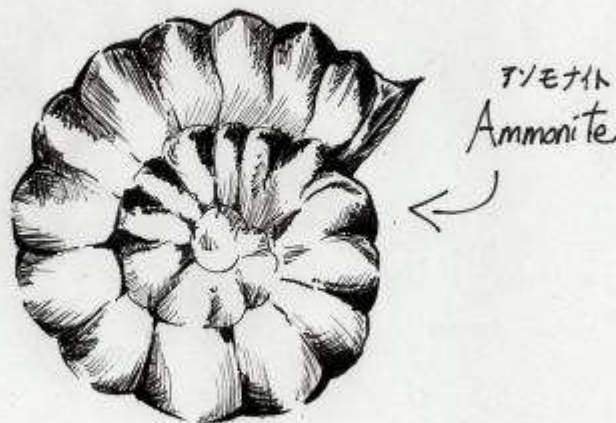

## 「Earthquake in Turkey and Syria」

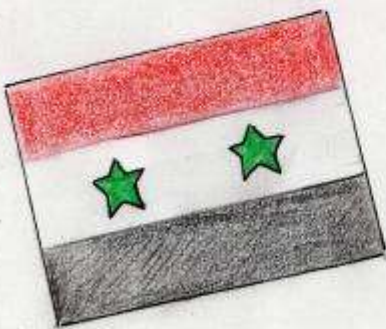

## 「Snowfall Warning」

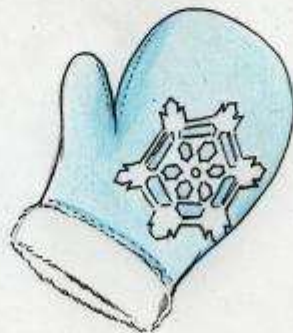

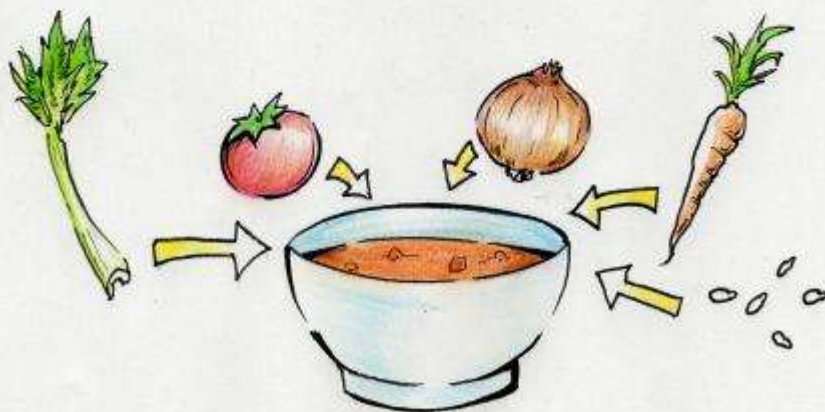
Italian food is popular around the world.

## #49 「Storing Potatoes」

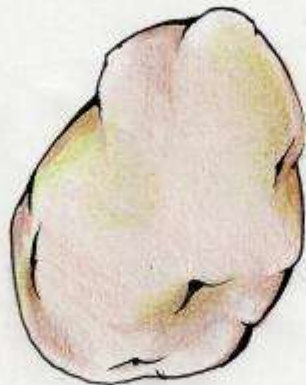

## #20 「Pot-au-feu」

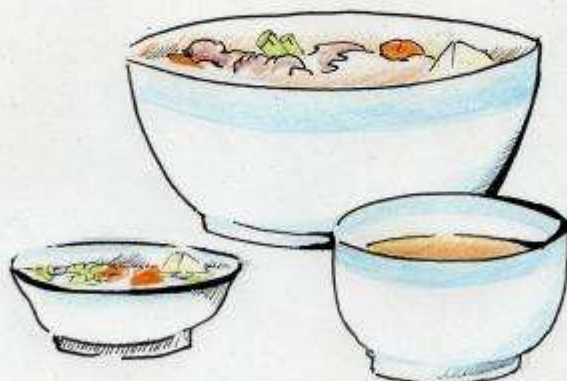
